SOFTWARE DEVELOPMENT **COMES IN MANY FORMS.**

At times it can be quite transactional, with developers only needing to 'plug-and-play' install with straightforward code. On the other end of the spectrum, some projects (particularly those involving the latest technologies) can demand both niche expertise and an appreciation for the sentiment or reasoning behind a project.

EXAMPLE CLIENT STORY

For one client, an established UK-based telecommunications provider, manual processes associated with their broadband services had become complex, constrained to specific teams, unreliable and far from cost-effective.

To remain progressive, they needed to transition to Cloud infrastructure and automation for updates and testing... but were hindered by a lack of available skills and knowledgeable resources internally.

Given our extensive history of supplying unique skillsets for this longterm client, Caspian One was approached to help. Requirements were scoped by a member of our Partner Network who had prior experience within the client's tech environment.

In collaboration with the stakeholders, granular project parameters were defined with clear objectives and milestones outlined. These have since been managed by our lead expert on the project, in biweekly meetings with our Project Hub and leadership teams that review the RAG status of deliverables, one-by-one.

This is an ongoing project due to end in 2023. At time of writing, the project is on-track, and the client is extremely happy with progress made; to the point which their CTO (during a tour of the lab environment we created), stated we were showing them how to develop on a large scale and be successful, something to learn from and rollout out companywide.
